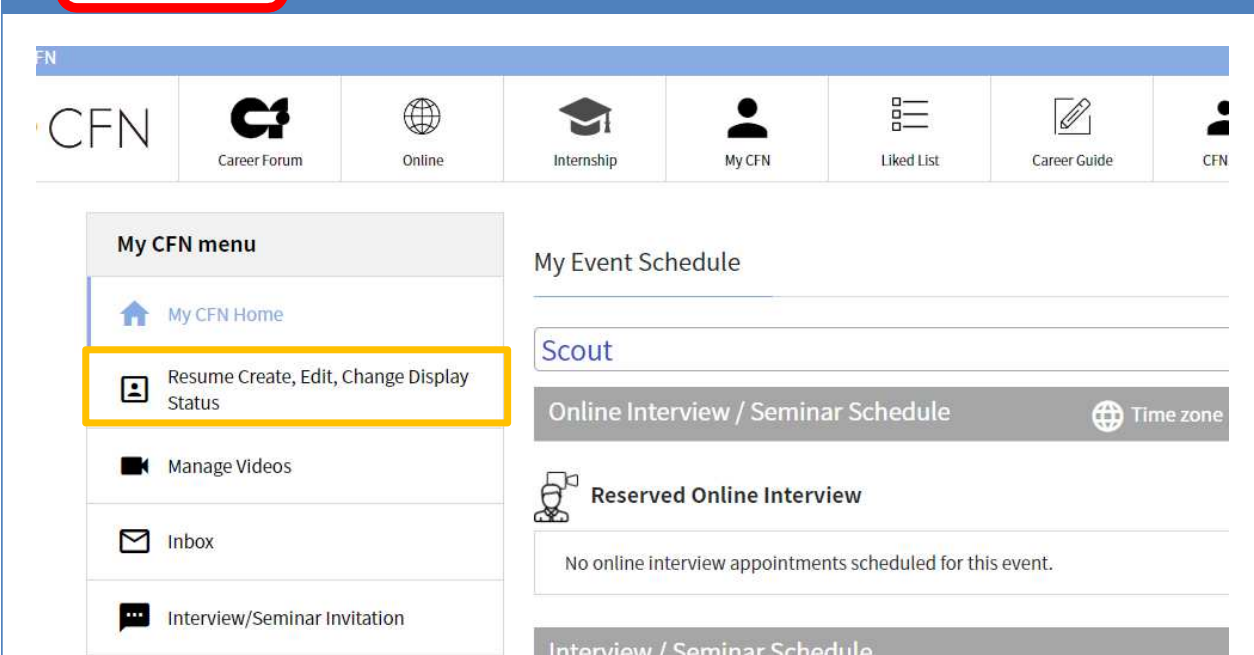
## Login to My CFN

## Complete Education Detail

### Enter most recent education first.

If you're studying abroad,  
make sure to include it too.

**No need to enter 3,000.**

**300~500 is suffice.**

**Focus on easy to read.**



**Include**

**past/present/future**

**Bullet points are ok!**

Past: Why this school (major)

Present: What are you studying

Future : How to apply what you've gained

## Complete Self-PR

Although not easy, you're almost there.  
**Complete Self-PR and you're done!**

\* By making your resume public, your current resume on CFN will be your scout resume including the Self-PR section. Limit this section to writing about yourself and avoid referring to a specific company.

\* Once you submit your application to a company, updating your current CFN resume will not affect the application already sent.

300-500/episode is suffice. At most 3 episodes,
